
A Rule of Life

Society of St. Simeon and St. Anna

The Episcopal Society of St. Simeon and St. Anna was founded by The Rt. Rev. Steven Charleston in 1991 with the first members inducted at the Diocesan Convention held in Fairbanks that same year.

The purpose of the society is to recognize, honor and celebrate the wisdom, experience, maturity and ministry of older persons in the Diocese of Alaska.

Members shall have at least 15 years as an active Episcopalian and be 60 years of age of older.

Nominations are by Parish Vestry, Parish Council, Church Committee or comparable body and are submitted to the Deanery.

Selection of members is prayerfully made by each Deanery at their annual meeting and submitted to the Diocese for affirmation at Convention.

Duties of the Society

The Society is a community at prayer. Members pray daily for the Bishop, Diocese and its people.

The Society is a council of elders. Members stand ready to share their wisdom with the Bishop and others when asked.

Members offer a valuable resource and model for Christian living to the church body throughout Alaska.

All persons in the Diocese are encouraged to look to the Society for images of life that are lived in imitation of Christ.

Rule of Life

Members of the Society are bound by a threefold Rule of Life:

To be constant in prayer

To be conscientious in ministry

To be compassionate in life

This rule is lived out by the Society in the following ways:

Society members pray for the Diocese of Alaska each day. Through their constant intercession, our church is supported and strengthened by the grace of God and the response of the Holy Spirit.

The on-going ministry of the Society is to serve the Bishop as a council of advice. Society members are expected to draw on their wealth of experience to assist the Bishop whenever he requests their wisdom and counsel.

Society members are to be living examples of the Christian witness. Through their compassionate lives of faithfulness to the gospel of Jesus Christ, they embody the hope of the gospel for all persons in the Diocese of Alaska.

A Prayer for the Diocese of Alaska

O God of grace and mercy, give your blessings to the Diocese of Alaska. Watch over our churches, sustain our people, and strengthen our leaders.

Through the Holy Spirit, guide and guard the Diocese, keeping it always under your care and protection.

Let us be a loving family, serving you in faithful devotion to the Gospel of your son, Jesus Christ, in whose holy name we pray. AMEN
