Delegate's Frequently Asked Questions:

• Where will I be staying? How do I make my lodging arrangements?

A group reservations with the Sheraton has been taken care of by the Bishop's staff. A list of guest names with check-in check-out dates has been provided based on your convention registration and travel dates. The room and tax will be charged directly to the diocese, incidentals are the individuals responsibilities. You may be asked for a credit card for incidental upon check-in.

• How will I get to & from the airport?

Ground transportation is the not provided and is the individuals responsibility. There are taxi cabs at the airport, or you may use ride-share apps (if you have them). The Sheraton does not have a complimentary airport shuttle.

• Will I have to pay for my meals?

Meals per the schedule will be provided; all other meals are on your own. (Thursday 9/29 Dinner; Friday 10/1 Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner; Saturday 10/2 Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner). Meals while in route and not listed on the schedule are your responsibility (no meals provided Sunday 10/2).

• What about parking?

For those who are local or are driving, the Sheraton has limited parking. There is a fee for daily and overnight parking. We have made arrangements with the hotel to have the parking fees for our registered guests (delegates & non-delegates) to be charged on the group account and billed directly to the diocese.

• What committee will I be on?

Committee assignments are made by the Bishop and his staff. Every attempt is made to follow the choices indicated on your registration form. The Committee assignments will be part of the delegate packets that are distributed at Convention Registration.

• Will Convention also be available online for those not able to travel?

We are not able to provide a "real-time" livestream of Convention. However, we are planning on videoing the plenary sessions and having the videos available on the Diocesan YouTube Channel; posted the week after Convention.
